Malaria, the most significant vector borne disease of public health concerns in India, is one of the major causes of loss of income and absenteeism in schools. The direct costs of malaria include a combination of personal and public expenditures on both prevention and treatment of the disease. The indirect costs of malaria include productivity or income loss due to illness or premature death.

During monsoon and post monsoon season, the breeding of vector mosquitoes responsible for transmission of malaria, and other vector borne diseases like Dengue, Japanese Encephalitis, etc. increase considerably due to collection of rain water everywhere.

“ANTI-MALARIA MONTH CAMPAIGN” is therefore observed every year in the month of June throughout the country to enhance level of awareness in the community about the Malaria and to encourage community participation, consolidate inter-sectoral collaborative efforts with other departments for prevention and control of malaria & other vector borne diseases. It is an effort to bring about healthy behavior changes in individual and societal level and feeling of ownership in fight against malaria and other vector borne diseases.

As a part of “Anti-Malaria Month Campaign a mass Social Service is being organized on 4th June'2016 from 0630 hrs. to 0830 hrs in all Govt. Institutions / Offices / Bazar areas & Villages in Lower Dibang Valley District.

All Head of Departments, Head of Institutions/Schools, PRI Leaders, Secretary Bazar Committee will be responsible for conduct of Social Service in their respective Locations and Villages.
