ORDER

WHEREAS it has been reported vide letter no. SECY/EDN/01/2016 Dated 23<sup>rd</sup> Oct 2016 that SSA Teachers Association of Arunachal Pradesh has declared 7 (Seven days) pen down strike starting from 24<sup>th</sup> October 2016; and

WHEREAS it has also been reported that regular teachers as well as teachers under RMSA have also decided to join the said strike for 2 (Two) days on 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> October 2016; and

WHEREAS after considering all the aspects Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh has decided to declare the 7 (Seven) days pen down strike as "ILLEGAL" and has directed to take tough action against the agitating teachers for defying the authority and assurances of the Government and going on strike at the cost of education of lakhs of students of the State; and

WHEREAS it is apprehended that teachers (SSA, RMSA, Regular etc) from Lower Dibang Valley district may also join the said strike starting from 24<sup>th</sup> Oct 2016, thereby hampering the interest of the students of Lower Dibang Valley district ;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Deepak Shinde, IAS, Deputy Commissioner , Lower Dibang Valley district hereby declare the said strike of teachers (SSA, RMSA, Regular etc) starting from 24<sup>th</sup> Oct 2016 as "ILLEGAL" and direct the following:-

1. All teachers shall attend schools and discharge their assigned duties as per schedule;
2. The pen down striking days shall be treated as "NO WORKING DAYS" and the provision of "NO WORK NO PAY" shall be invoked against all the striking SSA/RMSA teachers. No salary shall be paid for the striking SSA and RMSA teachers for the striking days during the month of Oct 2016;
3. The two days strike by regular teachers under the banner of ATA on 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> Oct 2016 shall be treated as "NON DUTY PERFORMING/ ABSENT DAYS" and shall be deducted from their EL/CL at their credit. Further, till the said absence / non-performance for two days is regularised by the competent authority, no pay for these two days shall be released to the regular teachers in the month of Oct 2016. Headmaster/ Principal and DDSE, Lower Dibang Valley district are directed to ensure the same;
4. It is further reiterated that as per **CONDITIONS OF APPOINTMENT AND CONTRACT AGREEMENT** of SSA/RMSA teachers, the teachers have no right to claim for regularisation of the services rendered on contract basis and their services are liable to be terminated at any time by a notice in writing;
5. Headmaster/Principals/Teacher In-charge shall send the daily factual report along with the list of striking teachers to the DDSE through the concerned CRCC/BRCC/BEO or Supervisory Officer deputed by DDSE for the said purpose for taking necessary disciplinary actions. The complete list with the name of teachers should be forwarded to the Deputy Commissioner for further necessary action on all working days by 1630 hrs.
6. All Administrative Officers shall keep strict vigil on all striking days and send daily report on all striking days to Deputy Commissioner, Lower Dibang Valley district.
